

No. 2 Power Unit Restarted at Onagawa Nuclear Power Station

January 27, 2008

We hereby announce that we restarted the No. 2 Power Unit at 21:00 hours on January 27, 2008, at our Onagawa Nuclear Power Station, thus completing the 9th regular inspection activities that commenced on October 11, 2007.

We intend to gradually raise the output of the nuclear reactor, and while ensuring the safety of all systems involved, will restore the unit to commercial operation.
