Donations to Tohoku Green Power Fund in Fiscal 2007

Tohoku Electric Power Co., Inc. will make a donation of 40 million yen for fiscal 2007 to the Tohoku Green Power Fund operated and managed by the Industrial Vitalization Center for Tohoku.

The Tohoku Green Power Fund was created in October 2000. It is based on donations from consumers of electric power—both individuals and corporations—who want to contribute to preserving the environment, and is selectively applied to support new clean energy power generation projects, including those based on solar and wind power.

As an electric utility provider, Tohoku Electric Power Co., Inc. is eager to support efforts to promote the utilization of natural energy sources. The Company makes donations to the fund each year, the amount of which varies depending on the overall picture, including the amount of funds needed for solar or wind power generation projects, fund operating expenses, prospects for future fund requirements and so on.

We continue to encourage as many people as possible to contribute to the fund, and are confident that funds raised from all donors, including Tohoku Electric Power Co., Inc. will be used to make a significant contribution to promoting the utilization of locally available, sustainable natural energy that creates no CO₂ emissions.
