Minato Unit No.2 Operating Again at Higashi Niigata Thermal Power Station

Today, at our Higashi Niigata Thermal Power Station, we restarted operations of Minato Unit No. 2, which has been out of service due to inspections since January 2008.

In our power supply program planned in fiscal 2007, Minato Unit No. 2 was listed for a long-term scheduled shutdown. However, in our new power supply program for fiscal 2008, we decided to bring the unit back on-line in June so that we can be sufficiently prepared for the increased power supply demand during the coming summer season.
