Resumption of Power Generation by Onagawa Unit 1

Unit 1 of the Onagawa Nuclear Power Station resumed power today at 5:00 am when the output of the reactor reached the required level. The reactor had been restarted at 4:00 pm on March 18.

Power adjustment operations will now continue as the final phase of the regular inspection until the final examination by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry takes place. The final examination, scheduled for mid April, 2009, will complete the regular inspection.
